

Dr. M. Aykut Attar was born in Ankara in 1981 and graduated from Yüce High School of Science in 1998. He received a bachelor's degree in economics from Hacettepe University in 2003, a master's degree in economics from Ankara University in 2005, and a Ph.D. degree in economics from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 2011.
