

ERCAN UYGUR: CURRICULUM VITAE

Received a B. Sc. in Economics and Statistics from the METU; an M. Sc. in Economics from the University of Warwick (UK); a Ph. D. in Economics from the University of East Anglia (UK) where he also taught part time. Appointed to the Faculty of Political Science of Ankara University in 1977, where he became Associate Professor in 1983 and Professor in 1989. Retired at end-2010 after also serving as Chair of the Department of Economics for 8 years. Taught part time at Koç University during 1994-2011. Researched at the University of Oslo (Norway) during 1981-82 and at the University of Pennsylvania (USA) during 1988-89 as part of the Project-Link team. He has been teaching and Vice Rector at the Final International University (North Cyprus) since July 2016.

Researched/published in Macroeconomics, Macroeconometric Modelling and Growth. He has a total of 13 books, four of them in English, and around 100 articles and discussion papers published, 34 of them in English and two of them translated to Spanish. He served as consultant to the World Bank (2009, 2010, 2011), United Nations-UNCTAD (1998, 2000), International Labour Organization (1993), Wharton Econometric Forecasting (1990-91). He was consultant at the State Institute of Statistics (1990-96); Treasury (1997-2000); and the Central Bank (1988-94 and 1997-98). He has been a member of the Advisory Board of the International Economic Association since June 2011, a consultant to the Kyoto Scientific Prize since September 2012 and the editor of the economics journal Ekonomi-tek since January 2012.
